The Fallacy

Does Jesus need to say the words directly, “I am God, worship me?” No. That is a Fallacy of Imposition - Imposition modern phrases into ancient texts.

In the same way, Muhammad never said word-for-word, “I am Allah’s perfect moral example, follow me.” The concept is there, but not the exact wording.

The Great “I Am” & Jesus

When Moses asked for the name of God before he went to Egypt to see the people set free, God told him:

Then Moses said to God, “If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they ask me, ‘What is his name?’ what shall I say to them?”¹⁴ God said to Moses, “I AM who I AM”...This is my name forever, and thus I am to be remembered throughout all generations” (Exodus 3:13-15).

This is why Jesus took on the name “I AM” and it is why they wanted to kill him.

John 8:12 — “I am the light of the world”
John 10:11 — “I am the good shepherd”
John 11:25 — “I am the resurrection and the life”
John 14:6 — “I am the way, and the truth, and the life”

Yahweh’s Name was “I AM” and They wanted to Kill him as He claimed to be God.

Jesus said, “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father’s hand. I and the Father are one.”

Again his Jewish opponents picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus said to them, “I have shown you many good works from the Father. For which of these do you stone me?”

“We are not stoning you for any good work,” they replied, “but for blasphemy, because you, a mere man, claim to be God” (John 10:34-33)

He Said He was Yahweh

“Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see my day. He saw it and was glad.”

So the Jews said to him, “You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?”

Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was,

I AM.” So they picked up stones to throw at him, but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple” (John 8:56-60).

He Shared Glory. only God Has Glory

“When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, “Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you... And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed” (John 17:1,5).

Jesus Claimed to Fulfill th Daniel Prophecy

“I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him.
¹⁴ And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed” (Daniel 7:13-14).

And Jesus said, “I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven. And the high priest tore his garments and said, “What further witnesses do we need? You have heard his blasphemy. What is your decision?” And they all condemned him as deserving death.” (Mark 14:62).
