- The Bible was copied by many scribes
- The original readings can usually be reconstructed with high confidence
- No major Christian doctrine depends on a disputed text
- The church fathers provide over 1,000,000 quotations allowing us to fully reconstruct the New Testament, even without a single Bible.

The Bible

- 5,800+ Greek New Testament manuscripts
- 10,000+ Latin manuscripts
- 24,000+ total manuscripts in all languages (2nd century AD onward)
- Earliest fragment: P52, dated around AD 125–150
- Over 1 million quotes/allusions from Church Fathers

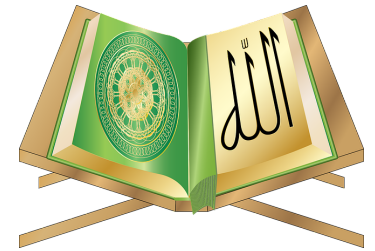

Is the Quran Perfectly Preserved?

The Muslim belief in the Quran's perfect preservation is Islam's greatest claim for divine inspiration. It is believed that the Quran is preserved down to every word, letter, and diacritical mark.

إِنَّا نَحْنُ نَزَّلْنَا الذِّكْرَ وَإِنَّا لَهُ لَحَافِظُونَ ٩

“Indeed, it is We who sent down the message [i.e., the Qur’ān], and indeed, We will be its guardian” (Quran 15:9)



Warning: This pamphlet contains words of the Qur’an in Arabic and English, so make sure you don’t dispose of it improperly.

A'isha said THIS was in the Quran, but then a Tame Sheep ate it.

“A'isha (Allah be pleased with, her) reported that it had been revealed in the Holy Qur'an that ten clear sucklings make the marriage unlawful, then it was abrogated (and substituted) by five sucklings and Allah's Apostle (ﷺ) died and it was before that time (found) in the Holy Qur'an (and recited by the Muslims)” (Sahih Muslim 1452a).

“It was narrated that 'Aishah said: “The Verse of stoning and of breastfeeding an adult ten times was revealed, and the paper was with me under my pillow. When the Messenger of Allah died, we were preoccupied with his death, and a tame sheep came in and ate it” (Sunan Ibn Majah 1944).

Quran 57:24: Hafs vs Warsh

Hafs Arabic: فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ هُوَ الْغَنِيُّ الْحَمِيدُ

Meaning: “Indeed Allah, **He** is the Self-Sufficient, the Praiseworthy.”

Warsh Arabic: فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ الْغَنِيُّ الْحَمِيدُ

- the word **هُوَ** is absent.

Meaning: “Indeed Allah is the Self-Sufficient, the Praiseworthy.”

Multiple Qurans = Multiple Differences

Verse 1: Surah Ali 'Imran (3:146)

- Hafs Arabic:** قَاتَلَ
- Hafs Meaning:** *he fought*
- Warsh Arabic:** قُتِلَ
- Warsh Meaning:** *he was killed*

So was he killed, or was he fighting?

Verse 2: Surah Al-Baqarah (2:184)

- Hafs Arabic:** مِسْكِينٍ
- Hafs Meaning:** *a poor person*
- Warsh Arabic:** فِدْيَةٌ طَعَامُ مَسَاكِينٍ
- Warsh Meaning:** *poor people*

Is a missing fast made up by feeding one poor person or many?

Verse 3: Surah Al-Baqarah (10:10)

- Hafs Arabic:** قُلْ لَوْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ مَا تَلَوْتُهُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَلَا أَدْرَأَكُمْ بِهِ
- Hafs Meaning:** “Nor would He have made it known to you.”
- Qunbal Arabic:** قُلْ لَوْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ مَا تَلَوْتُهُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَلَا أَدْرَأَكُمْ بِهِ
- Qunbal Meaning:** *And He would have made it known to you.”*

So which is it? Did Allah not make it known or did he make it known?

Uthman was Not a Prophet, yet He Burned All Other Qurans

Narrated Anas bin Malik: Hudhaifa bin Al-Yaman came to `Uthman at the time when the people of Sham and the people of Iraq were Waging war to conquer Arminya and Adharbijan. Hudhaifa was afraid of their (the people of Sham and Iraq) **differences in the recitation of the Qur'an**, so he said to `Uthman, "O chief of the Believers! Save this nation before they differ about the Book (Qur'an) as Jews and the Christians did before." So `Uthman sent a message to Hafsa saying, "Send us the manuscripts of the Qur'an so that we may compile the Qur'anic materials in perfect copies and return the manuscripts to you." Hafsa sent it to `Uthman. `Uthman then ordered Zaid bin Thabit, `Abdullah bin AzZubair, Sa`id bin Al-As and `AbdurRahman bin Harith bin Hisham to rewrite the manuscripts in perfect copies. `Uthman said to the three Quraishi men, "**In case you disagree** with Zaid bin Thabit on any point in the Qur'an, then write it in the dialect of Quraish, the Qur'an was revealed in their tongue." They did so, and when they had written many copies, `Uthman returned the original manuscripts to Hafsa. `Uthman sent to every Muslim province one copy of what they had copied, and **ordered that all the other Qur'anic materials, whether written in fragmentary manuscripts or whole copies, be burnt** ([Sahih al-Bukhari 4987](#)).
