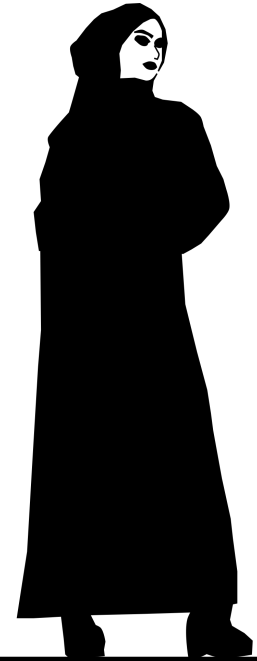

Do You Know Why Women Wear a Veil?

The shocking story from the authentic hadith, the sayings and teachings of Muhammad.

The Event Behind the Veil

(Islam's Prophet did not want women veiled).

“Narrated `Aisha:

The wives of the Prophet (ﷺ) used to go to Al-Manasi, a vast open place (near Baqi` at Medina) to answer the call of nature at night. `Umar used to say to the Prophet (ﷺ) "Let your wives be veiled," but **Allah's Apostle did not do so.**

One night Sauda bint Zam`a the wife of the Prophet (ﷺ) went out at `Isha' time and she was a tall lady. `Umar addressed her and said, "I have recognized you, O Sauda." He said so, as he desired eagerly that the verses of Al-Hijab (the observing of veils by the Muslim women) may be revealed. So Allah revealed the verses of "Al-Hijab" (A complete body cover excluding the eyes)" (Sahih al-Bukhari 146).

Sauda returned while Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) was in my house taking his supper and a bone covered with meat was in his hand. She entered and said, "O Allah's Messenger (ﷺ)! I went out to answer the call of nature and `Umar said to me so-and-so." Then Allah inspired him (the Prophet) and when the state of inspiration was over and the bone was still in his hand as he had not put in down, he said (to Sauda), "You (women) have been allowed to go out for your needs." (Sahih al-Bukhari 4795)

Allah agreed with Umar?

Narrated Anas:

`Umar said, "I agreed with Allah in three things," or said, "My Lord agreed with me in three things... 'O Allah's Messenger (ﷺ)! Good and bad persons visit you! Would that you ordered the Mothers of the believers to cover themselves with veils.' So the Divine Verses of Al-Hijab (i.e. veiling of the women) were revealed" (Sahih al-Bukhari 4483).

Who takes credit for veiling? It wasn't Muhammad, it was Umar.

The Dangrous Veil that Darkens our Hearts

Moses talks about another veil, one that covers the heart. It is far more dangerous.

“But their minds were hardened. For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted...Yes, to this day whenever Moses is read a veil lies over their hearts.” (2 Cor 3:14-15).

When we refuse to follow the Truth of the Word, our hearts become veiled through unbelief.

What/Who is Truth?

Truth is a person, and that person is Jesus Christ. Jesus said,

“I am the way, the truth, and the life” (John 14:6).

Who is Jesus?

The Qur'an says only God is “The First and the Last” (Qu`ran 57:3). Read when Jesus revealed himself to one of his companions as the First and the Last:

“His eyes were like a flame of fire, his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters. ¹⁶In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, “Fear not, I am the First and the Last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades” (Revelation 1:12-18).

Unveiled Hearts:

“But when one turns to the Lord, the veil is removed” (2 Cor 3:16).

“For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away” (2 Cor 3:14).
